Mission:

Leadership Academy provides a growing leadership pool of willing and able leaders and volunteers for current and future civic, charitable, and governmental organizations in Valparaiso.

OVERVIEW:

The Valpo Chamber Leadership Academy encourages individuals to be trustees of their community – to work for the common good – and to become a leader for the entire community. The program uniquely focuses on connection and engagement in community service – specifically, leadership roles.

The Valpo Chamber Leadership Academy complements other leadership organizations with a focus on the skills and knowledge necessary to be an effective leader in the community, for example, expectations of board service, governance, fundraising, ethics, accountability, and time management.

EXPECTATIONS:

In every session each participant should be actively engaged in discussions, class work and complete any outside assignments. Your presence, energy, ideas, and questions are essential to the full Leadership Academy experience. Candidates *must* have the full support of the organization they represent.

Graduation from the Leadership Academy does not signify an end but represents the beginning of a commitment to civic involvement. Participants are expected to become continually, substantively, and actively engaged within community organizations in leadership roles.

Throughout the Leadership Academy experience, participants will be exposed to various organizations and the leadership opportunities available for future engagement. Participants will also be provided with the tools to research and apply for available leadership roles.

TUITION:

Investment of \$600 per person as a member of the Valpo Chamber. Non-members may apply to participate; however, tuition will be combined with the cost of a membership with the Valpo Chamber. Tuition includes eight (8) sessions, all meals and materials for the program and reserved seating at the Valpo Chamber Annual Meeting which will be held in January of 2024. Upon notification of acceptance in the 2023 Leadership Academy, an invoice will be sent and tuition will be due by the first session, August 8.

TIME COMMITMENT:

Commitment to participating in the Leadership Academy centers on involvement. Class will begin promptly at 11:00 a.m. and end at 4:30 p.m. The dates for the 2023 Leadership Academy are listed below. Sessions will be held at various locations in the community. Attendance at all sessions is mandatory. Participants will be exposed to additional programs and events that can enhance their professional development, but they are not a requirement. The Leadership Academy may excuse absences because of extenuating circumstances. Dismissal from the program can result from unexcused absences.

SELECTION PROCESS:

The Leadership Academy seeks candidates who represent a cross section of the community and its institutions. Maximum enrollment is 25 participants. Every completed application will be reviewed. The class will include current and emerging leaders. Applicants will be notified of their participation by July 7, 2023. It is an honor to be invited to participate in the Leadership Academy. With so many qualified candidates from which to choose, the selection of each year's class presents a difficult challenge. Individuals who applied but were not selected in prior years are encouraged to reapply.

A maximum of two participants from the same business are allowed to apply and participate in Leadership Academy.

- Available time and full employer support to participate in the program and commitment to volunteer service after the completion of the program
- A passion for the people and future of our community, and a personal commitment to help improve the quality of life in Valparaiso
- A demonstrated capacity for leadership within their own organizations through significant achievement and experience relative to age
- Active within or interested in becoming engaged in the community through volunteer service and leadership
